

## TIMELINE

### EUTOPIA ROUND 2 CONNECTED COMMUNITIES

**MAY 21, 2024: ONBOARDING:** Online cross-CC meeting inviting leads and identified partners to have a first meeting with the central EUTOPIA team.

**SEPTEMBER 2024:** Leads of CC are asked to contact their partners at intra-community level in view of refining the timing and prioritisation of the deliverables mentioned in the letter of commitment.

*\*Contacts can be facilitated by the EUTOPIA MORE Local Facilitator appointed by the home university of the lead.*

#### FIRST YEAR OF OPERATIONS (2024-2025)

Three timeslots will be planned for contacts between each CC and the central team during the year. The local facilitator linked to the home university of the lead will facilitate and report on the meetings.

**1.) SEPTEMBER - END OCTOBER 2024: Initial Meeting at the start of the academic year:** Each community (lead and partners) hold their first meetings with the central team (Jo Angouri for curriculum related questions, Sigridur Beck for research related questions, and the central monitor Karen Triquet, as well as the two research-based learning promoters Kate Meier and George Turcas) to identify their needs for support and address any specific questions.

The resulting timeline and priorities for further actions will be communicated to the Research-Based Learning Promoters so that they can support the lead and partners.

**2.) JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2025: Mid-term Check-In:** With the help of the local facilitators, communities start to implement cross-campus activities, including reach out to students/researchers and/or local administrators if needed. Arrangements are made for blended activities and recognition of students'/researchers'/stakeholders' efforts.

*\*Aligned with instructions of the lead and partners, the central team will create visibility and support for all knowledge activities initiated by the lead and partners.*

**3.) MAY-JULY 2025: End-of-term Check-In:** Central team plans a meeting with each CC to provide feedback/advice on the pilot activities of lead and partners.

**(4.) TBA 2025 (OPTIONAL):** Central team plans a feedback meeting at cross-community level to identify the outcomes and challenges during the first operational semester.

#### SECOND YEAR OF OPERATIONS (2025-2026)

Three timeslots will be planned for contacts between each CC and the central team during the year. The local facilitator linked to the home university of the lead will facilitate and report on the meetings.

The last meeting takes the format of a cross-CC self-evaluation and reflection workshop. It is organized in person and is an important moment for assessing the sustainability of the partnerships and the possibility for integrating the cross-campus activities in the regular curriculum development and research portfolio of the home universities of leads and partners.
